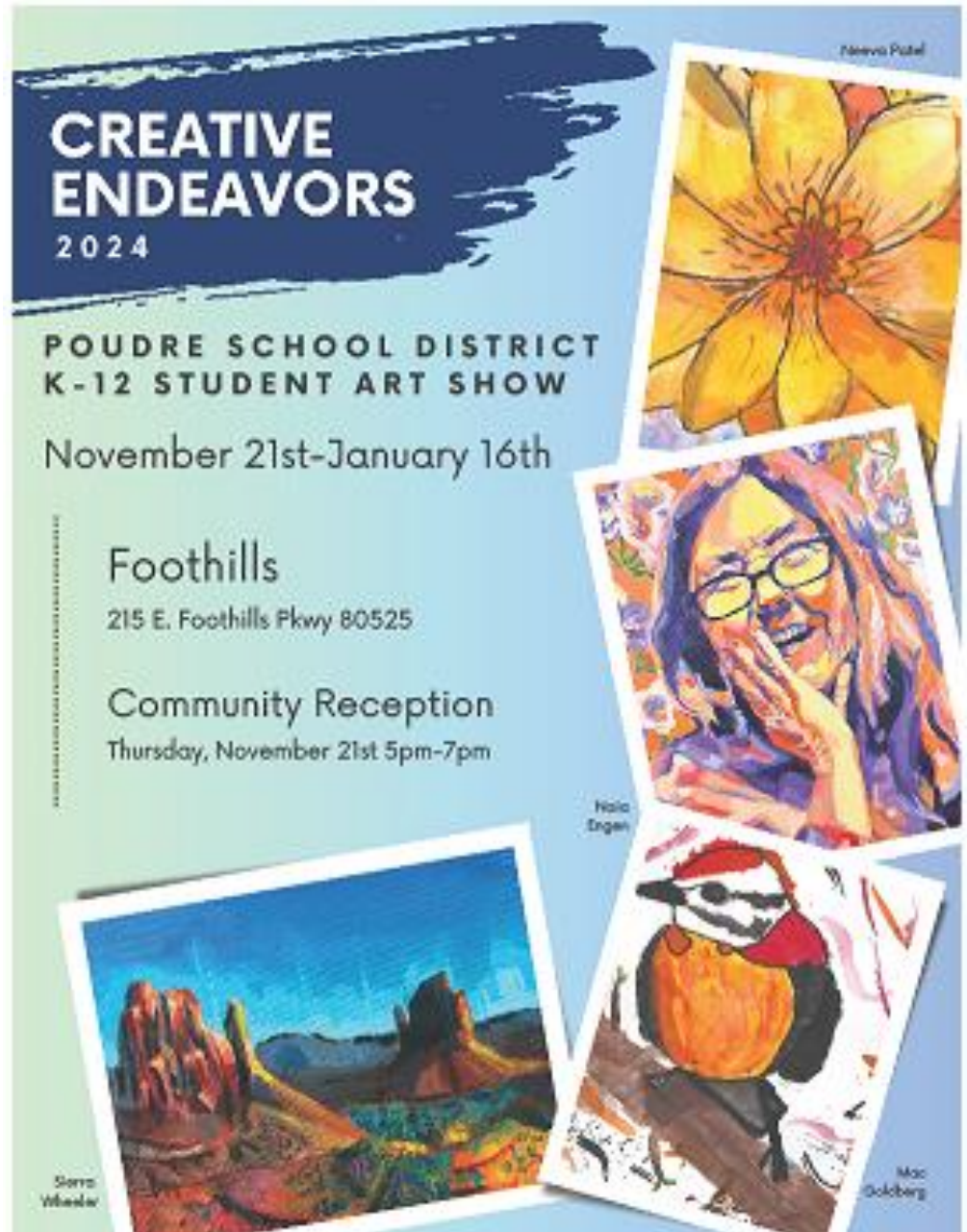
Bauder Attendance Policy

Student attendance positively impacts your student's academic future. Facts show that missing an average of 2 days a month negatively affects their academic performance. Did you know we are required to have a reason for your student's absence? When we don't hear from you on ParentVue or on the attendance line we must call each family. What can you do to help? You can report your student's absence. Our attendance line is available 24 hours a day, you can call and leave the reason for the absence at 970-488-4151. You can also use your ParentVue account to enter the absence. Absences can only be excused within 5 days of the date of absence. Thank you in advance for your help.
