Principal's Message

Hello Bauder families,



We've been back at school for almost 2 months now, can you believe it? Some of the excitement might be wearing off, but these next couple of months are very important as we settle into learning routines. Please make sure your child is getting plenty of sleep and eating a healthy breakfast. Limiting screen time is also important for your child's health. * This will set them up for a successful day at school. In addition to settling into learning routines and working hard on our core academic content, Bauder students are receiving regular instruction in Social and Emotional Learning (SEL). These SEL lessons are designed to help students acquire and apply the knowledge, skills, and attitudes to develop healthy identities, manage emotions, establish and maintain healthy relationships, and make responsible and caring decisions. So many of our students are taking these lessons to heart and helping to create positive and supportive classroom environments. Encourage your children to talk to you about what they're learning in school and how they can apply it in their lives. If you have any questions about how school is going, conferences (coming up next week) are the perfect opportunity to get those questions answered. We aim for 100% participation in our conferences. The parent-teacher partnership is crucial to your child's success. We look forward to seeing you!

** From the U.S. Surgeon General: "The most common question parents ask me is, 'is social media safe for my kids'. The answer is that we don't have enough evidence to say it's safe, and in fact, there is growing evidence that social media use is associated with harm to young people's mental health," said U.S. Surgeon General Dr. Vivek Murthy. "Children are exposed to harmful content on social media, ranging from violent and sexual content, to bullying and harassment. And for too many children, social media use is compromising their sleep and valuable in-person time with family and friends. We are in the middle of a national youth mental health crisis, and I am concerned that social media is an important driver of that crisis – one that we must urgently address."*


